Of the many Christian radio programs that are transmitted in various languages, EOM's *Yeni-gat Kokeb Dimts* (Voice of Morning Star) radio program is the one that I love and respect the most. My friends and I feel that your radio program has been the door that God has opened to satisfy our thirst for His word. It

amazes me how God uses your radio ministry to comfort those who have been jailed for their faith as well as other political prisoners. I witnessed this firsthand when I was in Eritrea. I thank God for using you and your ministry to help our brothers and sister who live all over the desert and countrysides of Eritrea to overcome the enemy.

I would also like you to know of a person who was in prison with me when I was in Eritrea. He used to listen to your program intently. After he got out of prison he was able to make his way to America. He told me he is now using the teaching you put on your website and has decided to surrender his life to Jesus and become His follower. Your teachings not only comfort and encourage those who are distressed in prisons and in difficult situations in Eritrea but also lead many others to Jesus.
